Our Vision

At All Saints we aim to '**bring faith to life in the centre of Kingston**'. Our strategy is to '**lift our voices, raise our profile and extend our outreach**'. To do this we have four priorities:

1. **Pioneer** new ways to engage with **children and young people**
2. **Raise** our profile and extend our outreach through better **communications**
3. **Invest** in our **partnerships** so that we can better understand the needs of our community
4. **Work** to become an **Eco Church**

In the coming year we hope to:

- Grow our Junior Choir and integrate more families into our congregation
- Provide more Faith Talks and discipleship courses
- Undertake urgent external repair work to our historic building.

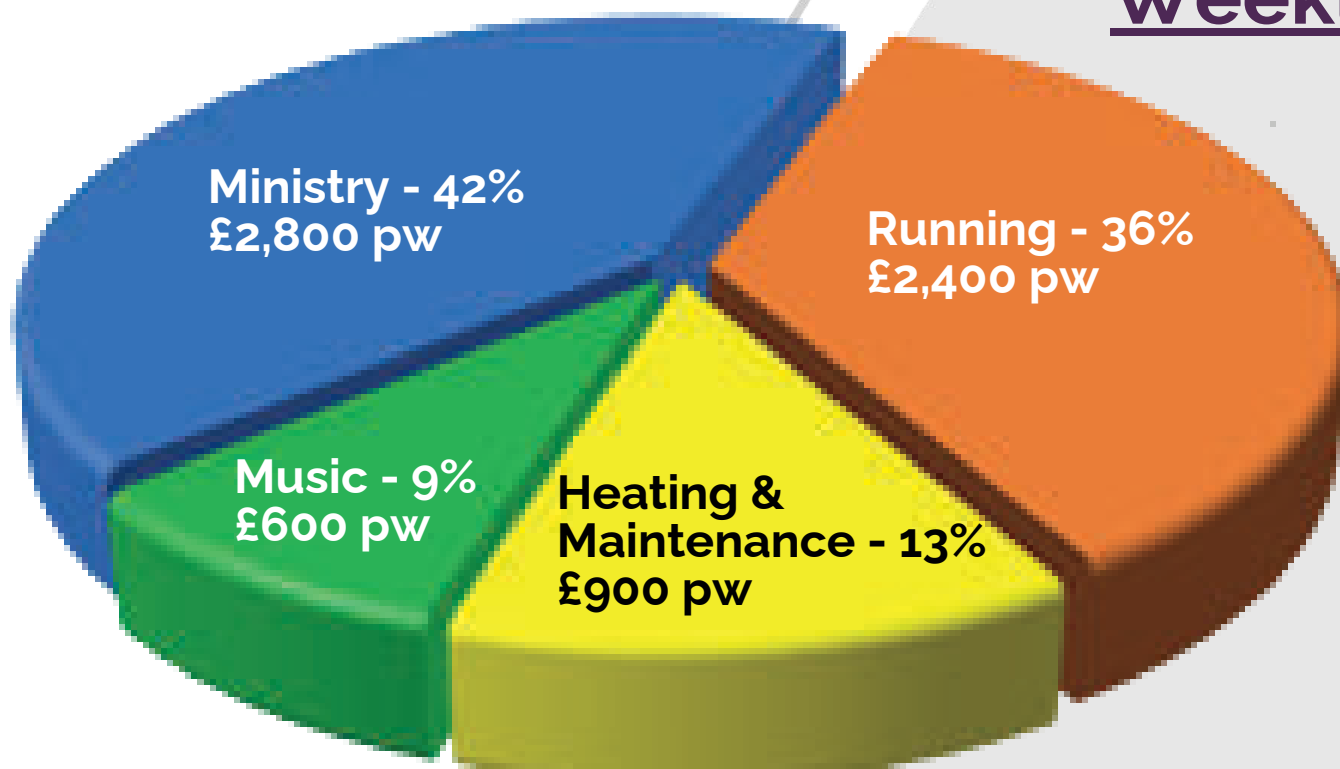
Our Costs

To fulfil our vision, we budget to spend £6,700 a week with costs set to increase by £300 (c5%) in 2026.

Our weekly spend consists of:

- £2,800 including our contribution to the diocesan Parish Support Fund which pays for clergy costs.
- £2,400 on running costs e.g. salaries, office costs, insurance etc
- £900 on heating and maintenance.
- £600 on music and choral activities.

Weekly Expense



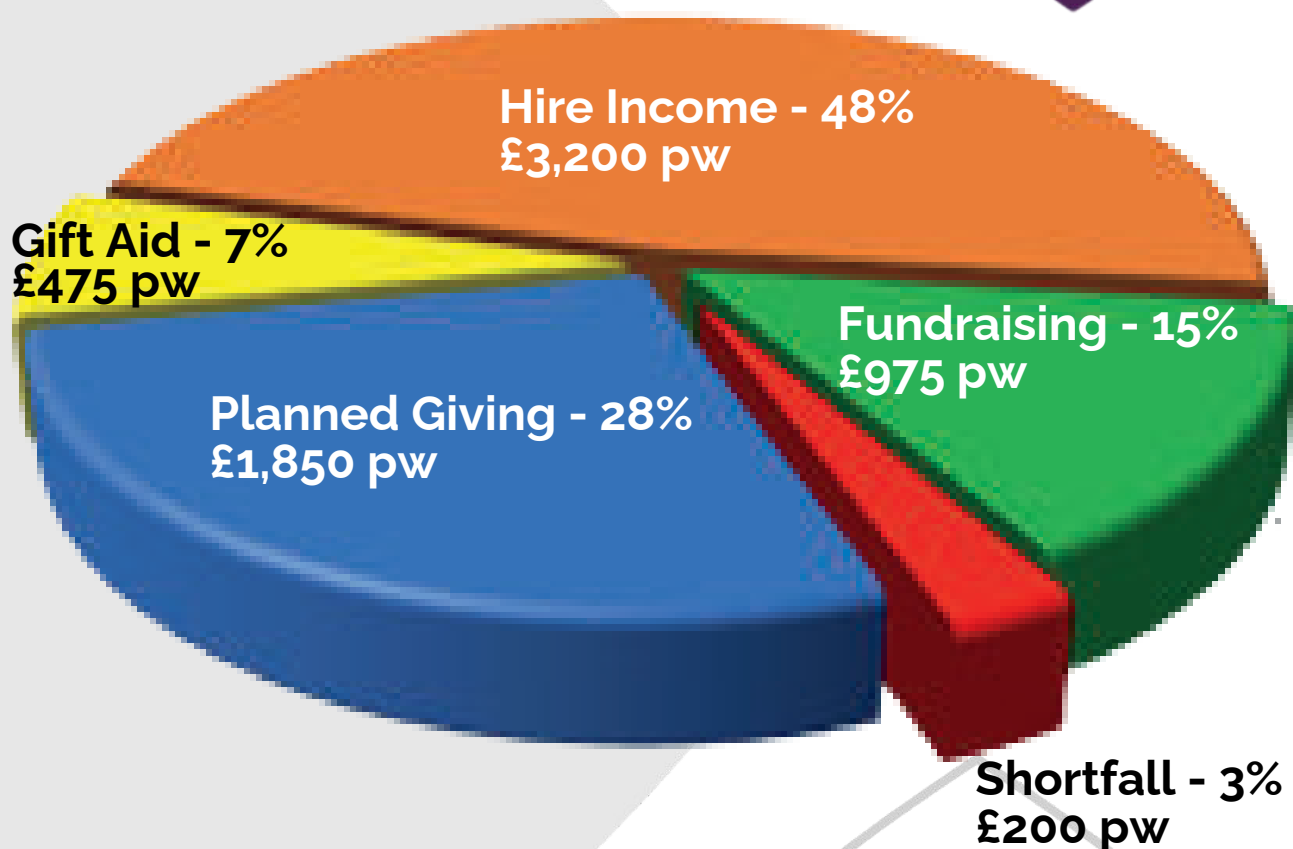


Our Income

Through 2025 we lost 10 planned givers who collectively contributed £150 weekly
 We currently receive £6,500 a week.

- We need an extra £200 a week (£10,000 a year) from planned giving to sustain our life together.
- We are aiming to fill this gap via a combination of securing 20 new regular givers and increases from current givers.

How Much Shall I Give?

We worship a generous God. Out of overflowing love for us, God sent Jesus His Son, who gave His life for ours.

Trusting in God's provision, we are called to reflect His love with open hands and hearts. Cheerful, intentional, generous giving is a natural part of the Christian life.

We could fund the gap between our ministry costs and our current income in this way: ➡

This many people	Increasing their weekly gift by	Equals this much extra weekly income
20 new	£5	£100
94 current	5%	£100

The bible teaches PROPORTIONATE GIVING – giving back to God a percentage of your income. The Church of England challenges us to give 5% to our church, and 5% to charity.

As a rough rule of thumb:

5% = £1 per week for every £1,000 of annual income. For example, 5% of an income of £10,000 = £10 per week

By comparison, a cup of coffee costs around £3.50 and a Netflix subscription is £18 a month

What Shall I Do Now?

Please **REVIEW** your giving prayerfully

If you currently give via the collection, please consider setting up regular giving via the **Parish Giving Scheme**.

This ensures that your giving is consistent and that gift aid is collected efficiently. It's easy to set up, just click on the **Donate** button on our website or scan the QR code below.

Hard copies of the PGS form are available at the Welcome Desk and can be returned to the Treasurer, Mr Gareth Williams, via the Parish Office.

If you currently give in a regular way via Standing Order, please consider moving to the Parish Giving Scheme. Every penny you give will continue to go to the church, but it will heavily reduce the administrative burden on our Treasurer. It also provides an option to keep up with inflation at the beginning of each year.

However you give, please consider an increase of 5% or more to help us keep up with rising costs.

We would be very grateful if you could register with the Parish Giving Scheme or inform the Treasurer of any increase to your Standing Order by the end of March 2026.
